Congo

As we are venturing into the Eastern part of DRC, we are sending our Kenya team in to start the work. In line with our vision that Africans can reach Africa and that Africa has to become a mission sending continent, we believe the best people to reach the Swahili speaking people in DRC are our Swahili speaking team members from Kenya. With a phenomenal team of strong leaders and ministers, our team made three trips into Congo this year. One of the trips was made by car, driving from Nairobi and all the way through Uganda to the Eastern part of DRC. The

other trips were made by the newly opened flight route from Nairobi, Kenya to Goma, DRC.

Our team has been having pastor and leadership seminars for church leaders who for the most part have no formal education. The Congolese pastors are eagerly waiting for more training to better learn how to be a good leader and to grow their churches.

In addition, we have started a bi-weekly radio teaching that reaches 2 million Congolese in both Lingala and Swahili. East Congo is a war-ridden and conflict filled part of Africa. From local guerrilla groups fighting for control to youth violence and drug abuse, East Congo is filled with uncertainties and instability. While our team was there, they witnessed uproar and violence although they themselves were spared. Shortly after, Goma had a volcanic eruption that caused even more suffering.

In 2022, we will continue to teach these pastors and leaders and give them proper training in the Word and in entrepreneurship.


Graduation


