

Vision








Judiciary

Notably, during one of our visits, we had the privilege of meeting judges from South Sudan who had come to Kenya to glean insights from the Kenyan judiciary.

In a realm where invitations to engage with the court system are exceedingly rare, our ministry has been given extraordinary favor. The impact of our work resonated so profoundly that even the principal judge of the high court attended our graduation ceremony, extending greetings on behalf of the Supreme Court Chief Justice. This recognition is a testament to the unique and valuable contribution our ministry is making within the legal community, fostering connections and collaboration that transcend borders. We are immensely grateful for the doors opened, and we look forward to continued opportunities to serve and influence positive change within the judiciary.





Building a Legacy – *Student Center in Mombasa*

Building A Legacy is our latest project in Mombasa, and we celebrated the groundbreaking ceremony in December 2023. The Mombasa campus is unique, providing boarding facilities that cater to the educational needs of many students. However, we currently lack a kitchen and dining area, essential components for the students' daily lives. The construction of this student center is crucial to filling this gap and enhancing the overall learning

Rhema Bible Training College Kenya

Our multisite school offers campuses throughout Kenya in order to train leaders and transform people in their local communities. Three of our campuses, Nairobi, Mombasa, and Kisumu, offer the 2-year program, while the other campuses only do one year. The students from these first-year only campuses come to Mombasa to board for their second year. At the end of their second year, all the graduating students come to Nairobi for the graduation. In these two years, lives are changed from the inside out as the Word of God has been richly sown into their hearts.

In November, we marked a significant milestone with the 10th graduation ceremony at Rhema Kenya. The event drew graduates from across the country to Nairobi, a testament to their remarkable dedication and sacrifice throughout the transformative two-year program. This celebration marked not only their amazing achievements but also the life-transforming journey they have embarked upon in these two years. 2023 RESULTS



Congo

Our ministerial training in Eastern Congo (DRC) was very successful in the first year of running. 35 leaders successfully completed 4 modules in Goma, DRC and 15 of these are continuing their studies in Kenya for their second year. This is a huge milestone and a barrier that is being broken. Most of these pastors live in constant fear for their lives where bombs and shootings are a daily occurrence. As some of these are coming from other cities, several of them experienced road closures by rebel groups that made it impossible to come by road. One pastor traveled 7 days by road and 12 hours by ship just to come for the training. Although most of our teaching is about Biblical and ministerial training, we also focus some of the teaching on entrepreneurship. Some of the testimonies from our students are amazing.

Forwarded

Team from Butembo and Beni who couldn't use road fuel to rebels, but sacrificed to pay air tickets to make it to class

This pastor was attacked by thugs in his house, around 40 of them, they stole most of their house goods, his son was cut on his head, admitted in hospital but this pastor pushed to make it to class for the two weeks, he did class, rushed hospital and back. His son is out of danger, glory

Forwarded

This man escaped death very narrowly. He had gone to his cocoa farm to harvest to sell to raise transport and fees for himself and his wife. Rebels invaded that village, killed 13 people, he and his family escaped. He still sacrificed to come to class with his wife. Mai roads from Beni to Goma closed by rebels, they paid their return air ticket to make it to class. They still paid their fees though very sacrifialy. They are going back and believe, they will teach their people faith


Economic struggles persist, with limited formal job opportunities and inadequate educational and healthcare facilities.




